REVIEW MINUTES

Bev reviewed the minutes from the November meeting. Minutes accepted as read.

MISCELLANEOUS

- a) We need to check the dates of re-appointments for the Board members. Mr. Cluff said he would check on that.
- b) Bev brought up an idea of playground equipment for adults and elderly as pictured in the AARP magazine.
- c) Brooke suggested switching our meetings to quarterly or every other month. Discussion was made that it could be based on what's coming that month. Further discussion set for next meeting.
- d) Newsletter – Start highlighting individual parks again. There was discussion regarding sledding hills. Maybe include some kind of apparatus at the top of the hill at Heritage Park so it increases the length of the hill.

ADOPT-A-PARK PROGRAM

No one appeared at the meeting. We need to put a list of the parks that need to be adopted in the newsletter. We need to remind everyone that the parks are paid for and maintained by tax dollars and it's in everyone's interest and responsibility to help maintain and enjoy them. It was pointed out that the recent vandalism of the bathroom facilities cost the city thousands of dollars and required the facilities to be shut down for the repairs. Kent suggested setting up a reward for those who turn in vandals. Terry said that we always say "See something, say something" so maybe we need to include a phone number for people to call, besides "911". Mr. Cluff said we could put the list of parks on the city's website and recognize those who have adopted a park. Jason suggested that maybe they could be included in the Heritage Days parade. Terry said he would talk to the Mayor and have him highlight the Adopt-a-Park program in his newsletter contribution.

There was discussion about asking commercial establishments to adopt, also Lakeside Church or Cornerstone Bible Church (former Board member Justin was the pastor there). Need to include other church groups to see if they would be interested. A suggestion was made that maybe adopters could be given hats to show they were volunteers as they worked in the parks. (It should be noted that Mayor Stanger stopped in to the meeting and said he would help promote this program.)

DISC GOLF - UPDATE

Jason said that everyone is waiting for the spring thaw to do the upgrades to the course. He is also waiting to hear from Zac regarding the sign information, so he will report back to the Board in February. The earliest we can make sign changes is late March and early April. Mr. Cluff said he would check with Zac also. Jason said that he and Brooke need to look into tournament planning due to the earlier start of Heritage Days.

Heritage Days is set for June 9th and 10th.
