The March 17, 2021 meeting was held at 7:00 PM via Zoom.

Motion by Jason to approve the last minutes; seconded by Terry. Motion carried.

HERITAGE DAYS

Mr. Cluff said it is scheduled for July 9th & 10th, but we'll have to see where the Governor is at the end of June. Unfortunately we'll need to decide before that; possibly by mid to late May to make a decision. He said that the parade and fireworks would probably be okay, but the vendor booths are something different. He said that the Covid numbers are down and the vaccinations are up, but we may still have to modify some activities. Marie pointed out that the Governor may be opening things up to more people by April 1st.

DISC GOLF

Jason said that he still wants to mix up the course for variations and we still need better signs for safety purposes. A scout made some mandatory signs but did not contact Jason so the signs made did not include the safety precautions.

PARKS

Mr. Cluff said that there is new playground equipment at Meadows and the parking and pickle ball courts are in process. He doesn't have a list of what the Parks Department wants for this year yet.

Regarding Pond Park, there was a plan for the east end but they have been halted due to some problems. We need to resolve the parking problems; plans for a bathroom, play equipment, etc. was shut down by the neighbors because of the proposed parking lot. Marie said that she's heard from 2 neighbors who want playground equipment.

Mr. Cluff said that he would like to incorporate disc golf at another area with 1 or 2 baskets that can be used for practice. He said the area under the power lines to the north of City Hall would work, but the land is private property now. It's something to think about. Maybe even incorporate disc golf idea on the trails.

Terry said that maybe we could look at some exercise areas along the trails too.

Mr. Cluff said that the city will be looking at another grant for the Civic Center park area land exchange when the Meadows renovations are completed.
