REVIEW MINUTES

Bev reviewed the minutes from the March meeting (April meeting was cancelled due to not having a quorum). Motion by Terry to approve the minutes, seconded by Jason and motion carried.

DISC GOLF

Jason said he appeared before the City Council and the initiative was passed for adding basket locations. He said that Zac said it would be mid-July for installation and Mr. Cluff said that the city already has the anchors. Jason said he could help when he's needed. Mr. Cluff said that help is needed on the signage and Jason said he would research pictures, etc. and have the signs include the rules. He said that Zac would like a large sign to put on the outside wall of the restroom building and would be a cost of \$600 to \$1,000. There's discussion about putting a scan code on the sign for cell phones to use that would show the course layout, directions, and tips for the players. Kent asked if there could be hole sponsors. Jason said that would have to be researched for legality. He said he and Brooke are working on inaugural tournaments for disc golf and pickle ball for Heritage Days with prizes and followed by a survey for residents to register their opinions. The tournament would be July 7th at 7:30 PM with \$15 registration fee. If we want discs for our booth, it would be \$1 per disc to buy, with 50-100 mini discs stamped with the Heritage Days logo. Barbara said that Mr. Cluff had previously said to go ahead and order them. Jason said he was meeting on Friday to finalize plans for the tournaments.

MEADOWS PARK

Mr. Cluff said that Zac is working on getting rid of the voles and aerating, watering, and re-seeding will begin soon. Also, people are throwing rocks onto the pickle ball courts and we'll need to clear that up.

BALLFIELDS

Kent said that the civic center fields need larger mounds for the pitchers. Brooke said she would look into that.
