### HERITAGE DAYS

Mr. Cluff said the Board has a booth, facing east, on the south end of the park. There will be a parade and food vendors this year but stage events won't start until 4:00 PM. Jason said he would check on getting the mini Frisbees for a give-away for the disc golf demonstration. Bev said she would check on other give-away promotional items. It was decided to start the booth at 11:00 AM, approximately, after the parade is over. Discussion was made to have a survey at the booth to see what kind of events people would like to see in the parks.

### PICKLE BALL

Terry said that the fences are up and cement work is done. Lights have been approved but when they will be turned off at night is yet to be determined. The last thing to be done is the parking lot. Mr. Cluff also said that there is to be a sound wall on the west side of the courts. The whole project should be done by July. If so, we can promote it at our Heritage Days booth. Marie said that there is talk of setting up leagues now with a possible tournament in the fall.
