### BOARD APPLICANTS

Rachelle Frederiksen and Russell Arave appeared before the board as applicants for the vacant seats of Scott Bailey and Justin Gort (see attached applications). Rachelle said she has been a resident of Clinton for 9 years and would like to help. Russell said he is retired and feels like he wants to help with the parks in the city. Mr. Cluff reviewed the parks for the applicants and in answer to Russell, he said that the parks maintenance people check the bathrooms daily and also check that all the playground equipment is working properly. Rachelle said that she would like to see more mulch instead of sand at the playgrounds. There was some discussion about the "digger" being broken at the handicap playground. The Board instructed the Parks division look into that.

Motion made by Jason to recommend to the City Council that Rachelle and Russell be appointed to the Parks Advisory board; seconded by Bev. Motion carried. Mr. Cluff said that their appointments would be on the next City Council agenda.

### HERITAGE DAYS

The survey taken at the Parks Board booth was reviewed (9 responses with multiple picks on some responses): 7 for movies; 5 for concerts; 3 for fishing; and 1 each for pickle ball and basketball tournaments. Jason said that the movies idea would be easy to set up. He said that maybe we could get food trucks to set up also.
