c) Baseball – Kent said we have problems with the ball fields in Clinton. He talked to Zac several years ago about the weeds, bad mounds; gravel at home plate, etc. He’s also talked to the Mayor and took him to look at the fields. Within days, it was fixed but has gone downhill since then. Jason pointed out that, unfortunately, baseball is not as important and cities are not allocating money to keep up the fields. Kent said that the mounds are not installed correctly. Mr. Cluff said that he had given instructions to have these things fixed and if they’re not being done, he will find out what’s happening. Kent said that there’s no equipment at the fields and everything must be done by a work order. If things are done properly now, by spring all the dirt, etc. will be settled by spring. Jason said that if the Recreation Department uses the fields that the city has control of, they need to be kept up.

Terry instructed Bev to put this item on next month’s agenda to follow up.
