Parade: Saturday, July 9, 2022. Begins @ 9:00AM

Check In: Meet at the Lowe's parking lot on Saturday, July 9, 2022 @ 8:00AM

MANDATORY Pre-Parade Meeting: Tuesday, July 5, 2022 @ 6:00PM located at the Clinton City Recreation building (1651 W. 2300 N., Clinton, UT 84015.) All entries must have a representative at the pre-parade meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to help prevent any misunderstandings by reviewing all guidelines and answering any questions.

RULES:

1. Entries must be appropriate for a family audience. We reserve the right to refuse or remove any entry expressing discrimination against any person, ethnic origin, disability, organization or any other offensive material or actions as determined by the Parade Committee. Any applicant unwilling to comply with the regulations is subject to immediate removal from the parade.
2. All participants must keep pace with the parade. Please do not allow no more than a 30'-40' gap between entries at any time along the parade route.
3. Entries consisting of live animals such as horses/ponies/donkeys, etc. are required to clean up after the animal(s). The City does not provide this service. Any violators will be charged a \$35.00 clean up fee.
4. For safety reasons you must have walkers/spotters who are at least 18 years of age, alongside your float or vehicle if you are distributing handouts, candy, novelty toy items or similar objects to the spectators. PLEASE USE CAUTION.
5. There is to be NO jumping on or off floats or vehicles WHILE THE FLOAT OR VEHICLES ARE IN MOTION during the parade. No one is allowed to ride on running boards, hoods, or vehicle fenders.
6. To ensure the safety of parade participants and spectators, the driver of the parade vehicle must possess a valid driver's license. The driver may not throw, discard, spray, or distribute any sort of items while operating the vehicle.
7. The following items are prohibited from being thrown from any parade entry; water balloons, water cannons, or objects that may cause any harm to spectators. Please remind your float participants to be respectful of spectators.

8. Performing groups please keep your routines to 30 seconds and close the gap between the float in front of you immediately after you finish the routine.
9. Parade entries must follow the direction of all parade officials and representatives.
10. Parade officials and representatives will determine the placement of each entry. Registrants will receive a number during check in.

I hereby hold harmless, and release Clinton City and its employees, assistants, representatives, volunteers, officials, and any other Clinton City representative from all liability, petitions, and causes of action which I, the participant, my heirs, representative, executors, administrators, or any other persons may make while acting on my behalf or on behalf of my estate or on behalf of the participant.

RELEASE/WAIVER

I, hereby recognize and acknowledge that my participation in the Clinton City Heritage Days Parade may involve bodily and/or emotional injury to myself and/or my parade entry participants. In consideration of myself/participants, being permitted to participate in the parade, I hereby voluntarily and knowingly release, waive, and discharge Clinton City, its officers and employees and parade officials from any and all liability that may result from myself or my participants participation in the parade. I hereby authorize Clinton City staff and parade officials to act on my behalf in accordance with their best judgment in case of an emergency and agree to assume full

responsibility for all medical expenses that may arise there from. By signing this document I hereby recognize and acknowledge that I will assume full responsibility for reading, understanding and adhering to all rules, regulations, policies and procedures. I agree that as a participant, I will fully comply with the rules of the parade. I understand that the Clinton City Police Department, C.E.R.T, Recreation Department, Parks Department and parade officials will monitor compliance with said rules. I understand that any violation of such rules may cause my participation in the parade to be immediately terminated. I agree that should I be notified of the termination of my participation by any of the above listed departments or officials, I will follow their directions immediately and peacefully. I agree to assume all liability and to hold Clinton City harmless from all claims resulting from any injuries or damage resulting from my actions, whether such actions constitute violations of said rules or not. I understand that notwithstanding the efforts of the organizers of the Heritage Days parade, hazards to my safety and to the safety of my property may exist. I agree to waive all claims against Clinton City and its parade organizers resulting from any injuries that may occur to me, including death and to any damage of my property.
