

Project Overview

Beginning August 5th, and continuing through Fall/ Winter of 2022, Clinton City will be reconstructing the roadway and replacing the culinary water line on 1300 North; from 1285 West to 500 West. The first phase of the project will stretch from 1285 West to 1000 West. The City will be replacing curb, gutter, sidewalk, and asphalt. For phase one, the road will be closed to through traffic for approximately five weeks. Eastbound traffic will be detoured at 1500 West. Westbound traffic will be detoured at 1000 West. Local traffic will be maintained.

*Please note that due to weather conditions, emergency situations or equipment/supply issues, schedules are subject to change.

- Active construction during daytime hours
- Noise and dust
- Road closures
- Traffic detours

Construction Timeline

- **Phase 1 (1285 W - 1000 W) :** August 5th to early Fall 2022
- **Phase 2 (1000 W - 500 W) :** Early Fall 2022 to Spring 2023
- **Phase 3 (500 W - Main St.) :** Spring 2023 to Summer 2023
