HERITAGE DAYS

Generally held the 2nd week of July

Heritage Days is a week long celebration that includes; a professional carnival, Miss Clinton pageant, dutch oven dinner, scrapbooking festival, golf tournament, 3 on 3 basketball tournament, 5-K fun run, breakfast in the park, parade, car show, entertainment, vendor booths, concert series, silent auction, concert in the park and ends Saturday night with a fireworks show.

MAYOR'S LUNCHEON

Once a month during the school year local elementary schools send one student from each grade to the city to have lunch with our mayor and city and school representatives. Children travel to and from their lunch in police and emergency vehicles and they are treated to lunch, games and interaction with school principals, police officers and fire fighters.
