LEAGUE RULES

The league will be a round robin format. Each team is guaranteed 8 regular season games. At the conclusion of the regular season, teams who have not forfeited twice will be ranked and placed into a tournament with a 2-game guarantee. The tournament is tentatively scheduled to begin on Wednesday, April 28th.

No new inning will begin after 1 hour and 10 minutes.

The 8 run rule is in effect after 5 innings or 1 hour.

League games can end in a tie, tournament games will be played to their conclusion using the International Tie-breaker if necessary.

A 6 run rule limit per inning will be used. A team will only be allowed to score 6 runs in any given inning. Once the sixth run crosses the plate the play is done and the team will go into the field.

Once the line-ups are in, the scorekeeper will give each team a new game ball. Teams will be allowed to keep these softballs.

Teams must bat at least 9 players, but have the option to bat all of their players present if they choose.

On bad weather days, teams may call 801.614.0796 after 3:00 pm for rainout information

Any teams receiving a minimum average of 3.5 **TEAM** sportsmanship points per game (see Team Sportsmanship Policy) will receive small commemorative gifts for all team members and coaches at the end of the season.

We need YOU, as parents, to help us to continue to emphasize these POSITIVE aspects of sports and be a role model for your young players.

Parents' "CODE OF ETHICS"

- *** | will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game and practice.*
- *** | will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.*
- *** | will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.*
- *** | will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all. I will refrain from the use of any foul language and/or negative comments towards any coach, player, referee, league official or spectator.*
- *** | will demand a "Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco FREE" youth sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all youth sports events.*
- *** | will remember that the game is for children and not for adults, and I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child by assisting with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing.*
- *** | will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and agree to the coaches "Code of Ethics".*

Team Sportsmanship Policy

In order for a team to be rewarded for good sportsmanship and receive commemorative gifts for all team members and coaches, they must accumulate the necessary sportsmanship points as written below:

- Teams must end this season (league and tournament games) with an average of 3.5 points per game. For example: if your team plays 8 league games and 2 tournament games (10 total games) they must end with at least 35 sportsmanship points.
- Teams will begin each game with 4 points. Each time a player, coach, or spectator from a particular team engages in unsportsmanlike activity, sportsmanship points will be deducted. Unsportsmanlike activity includes, but is not limited to: abusive language, excessive roughness, being ejected, continual complaining of calls and/or harassing umpires, and showing disrespect towards any league official including scorekeepers and supervisors.
- At the conclusion of each game the umpires and recreation staff personnel will determine sportsmanship points for the game.
- If a game officials feel that a team has shown exceptional sportsmanship, they can add a point to the sportsmanship score. Teams can earn a maximum of 1 point per game for a total sportsmanship score of 5 points.
- The supervisor at your facility will have record of all teams and their sportsmanship points.

Teams are responsible for all spectators, players and coaches. Please make sure that everyone is aware of this policy and remains positive so the players do not lose out on this opportunity. THANKS!
