### HERITAGE DAYS

Comments coming from Heritage Days: why weren't there any food trucks for lunch on Saturday; Kent wanted to know why we closed our booth at 4:00 PM. Since there weren't any shows in the afternoon, there weren't as many people in the park, plus our booth had been open since 11:00 AM, which made it a long day. Our updated Veteran's brick wall pictures really encouraged people to take an application for a brick order. The consensus was that this year's booth was the best, especially with the disc golf demonstration.

### PICKLE BALL COURTS

Mr. Cluff said that the city has received the "okay" for the grant, but the money probably won't come through until October, which means the courts will be a winter project. This grant, along with the cash donation, will pay for the courts and other improvements at Meadows Park.

### VETERAN'S PARK

Mr. Cluff said that another order of bricks will be going in soon and that should complete the 3<sup>rd</sup> wall. If we get more bricks ordered in the future, it will call for more wings installed on either end. Benches will also be installed and the flagpole, with a permanent light, will be installed, as well as concrete around the stone rock and walls. This will also help with handicapped visitors to the site.

### MISCELLANEOUS & NEWSLETTER

A) Disc Golf - Jason said that Zack had fixed the tee pads on 6 & 7 which should make it safer. The signs are here but not installed yet. Mr. Cluff said that should be done as soon as it cools off and the mowing schedule slows down. Jason said that the World Championships for disc golf will be held in 2020 at Ft. Buenaventura.
