IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ONLINE UTILITY PAYMENTS

Clinton City offers a convenient way to pay your utility bill each month through our online bill pay program. This service is offered through XpressBillPay.com and is a safe, secure, convenient, and FREE payment option.

Recently there have been companies popping up on the web which charge fees for paying your bill. Some of these companies are legitimate however, some are not!

For the safest, most convenient way to make your payment, start from the official Clinton City Web Site of www.clintoncity.net and click **PAY MY UTILITY BILL**, which will take you to XpressBillPay.com where you can securely pay your bill using a credit card or e-check by establishing your account through XpressBillPay.com.

Once your account has been created at XpressBillPay.com some of the other enhancements offered to Clinton residents include the ability to view complete bill details, in addition to payment history. Residents interested in recurring payments can sign up for that option on line as well.

Remember, this is the only way other than through your bank or credit union to make sure your Clinton City Utah utility bill is paid accurately and on time with no additional fees.

If your information on file is not accurate, and you have not registered on our website, you may not receive EMERGENCY NOTICES through our system. Please call our Utilities Department at 801-614-0700 to update your information.

If you are an owner of a rental property, please encourage your renters to register for notifications on our website so they will receive notifications.

When registering, please make sure to respond to the verification email to complete the registration process.
