Offices to be voted on in the 2019 Clinton City Municipal Election are:

- Three (3) City Council Members - 4 year terms each.

Declaration of Candidacy Forms or a Nomination Petition must be filed in person with the City Recorder at 2267 N 1500 W Clinton, Utah from Monday June 3, 2019 to Friday June 7, 2019 between the hours of 8am and 5pm. (UCA 10-3-301)(5 days only!!).

Candidates are subject to financial disclosure requirements identified in (UCA 10-3-208).

The Primary Election if needed will be held on Tuesday, August 13, 2019. The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. See the City website. www.clintoncity.net for more information and forms.

Please remember Title 18 of the Clinton City Code of Ordinances defines a Nuisance as: any unsightly or injurious object, structure, or disused or abandoned motor vehicles or equipment, or injurious or noxious weeds, trash, junk, refuse or garbage, grass or weeds over ten (10) inches high, or anything dangerous to human life or health, or anything rendering the soil, air, water or food to be impure or unwholesome.

SOLID WASTE RATE INCREASE

The Wasatch Integrated Waste Management District has announced a **\$2 rate increase**. The increase will support the construction and operation of a new transfer station and mixed waste processing facility at the site of the former energy recovery facility. This is a pass through fee to our residents that will become effective July 1; the garbage rate for residents will now be \$16.10 for the first can and \$12.50 for the second can per month. LANDSCAPING IN CLINTON IS REQUIRED

City Ordinance 28-3-21(1) requires all Front yard and visible side yards to be landscaped. Compliance with this ordinance is required within 18 months of construction of a new home which was built prior to April 2018 or removal of existing landscape. Beginning October 26, 2019 inspections will be done to verify compliance. Please complete your landscaping to avoid being in violation of this ordinance. CEMETERY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMORIAL DAY.

Memorial Day is observed on the last Monday in May. On the Thursday prior, crews do a thorough clean-up, preparing the Cemetery for this important day. Patrons should remove items they wish to keep prior to this clean up. After that cleanup, decorations may be placed anywhere on the burial space including the grass or headstone and remain there until the 2nd Thursday following Memorial Day when another general clean-up will take place. All remaining natural flowers will be disposed of and decorations will be removed and stored at Public Works Building for 2 weeks to collect.
