#### CLINTON CITY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

Clinton City has recently upgraded to a new emergency notification system. Now is a good time to sign up. To do so, click on the **Red Phone** (below) or go to [www.clintoncity.com](http://www.clintoncity.com) and click on the **Red Phone there**. By registering, you can specify how you will receive notifications and you can keep your profile updated with accurate contact information to insure you are notified of important information or of an emergency.




#### EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

If you have previously signed up, due to the migration to the new system, it is necessary to recreate your password. We have made every effort to transfer as much contact information as possible. To recreate your password please follow the log on link at <https://clintoncityut.regroup.com/login>, choose login, then put your email address in and choose the reset password option, this will cause the system to send you a password reset link. With the new system an email is required; if you do not have an email address please contact Lisa at 801-614-0700.

Please note that our Emergency Notification System is automatically and regularly updated through our Utility Billing system. If your information on file is not accurate, and you have not registered on our website, you may not receive EMERGENCY NOTICES. Please call our Utilities Department at 801-614-0700 to update your billing contact information.

If you are an owner of a rental property, please encourage your renters to register for notifications on our website, as this is the only way they will receive notifications or alerts.

### CHRISTMAS TREE SAFETY TIPS

When choosing a natural Christmas tree, always pick one that is fresh and not showing signs of dryness or leaking sap.


Failure to keep a Christmas tree moist and packing it full of lights and decorations increases the dangers of a fire. The small dried limbs and needles can become dry and ignite easily due to the concentration of hot lights, and flammable/combustible decorations, including popcorn etc... Make sure Christmas trees are at least three feet away from any heat source, like fireplaces, radiators, candles, heat vents or other types of lights.

According to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA):

- One of every three home Christmas tree fires is caused by electrical problems.
- Although Christmas tree fires are not common, when they do occur, they are more likely to be serious.
- A heat source too close to the tree causes roughly one in every four Christmas tree fires.

Please dispose of trees properly. **Christmas Tree Pick Up dates are Tuesday January 7 and Wednesday January 8, 2020.** Please have trees curbside by 6 am on Tuesday morning. Thank you!!

**NOTICE OF 2020 BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL**

Business licenses for the 2020 business year will expire on December 31, 2019. For convenience, renewal applications were mailed in November. If for any reason you did not receive a renewal application please contact the Clinton City Community Development Department at (801) 614-0740, and we will be happy to mail you another one. (Business license fees for renewal businesses, if applicable, shall be due and payable on or before January 1 of each year and shall be delinquent if not paid prior to February 1 of each year.)

**A REMINDER FROM OUR PUBLIC WORKS**

Please make sure to remove your garbage cans from the street once the garbage can has been emptied. Ordinance 13-5-9 paragraph (3) states: All empty containers or garbage receptacles must be removed from the street the same day they are emptied. This will help with sweeping in the Spring and Fall and plowing the street after a storm in the winter.

Also tree branches are only accepted at the Public Works shops from March through November. Please call 801-614-0780 with questions.
