Utopia Fiber will begin a project in Clinton in early October to bring WiFi broadband into a number of City park areas to provide free public WiFi access. City officials feel this high speed internet will assist the community by providing support for families participating in distant learning and/or parents who are working from home due to Covid-19.

This service will be provided by bringing fiber from West Point to the following parks: Heritage Park, Veteran's Park, Powerline Park, Civic Center Park areas and Pond Park. Other parks may be added if there is enough time.
