MAYOR'S MINUTE

Half-year State of the City- I am grateful for all those who have helped me learn the ropes these past six months. Lisa, our city recorder is amazing. She helps me keep our city council meetings on track. The city council is a well running machine. They have been wonderful to work with and patient with all my questions and comments. Our city staff are very hard working. I always look forward to hearing their reports and suggestions on what can be done to help Clinton be the best. We are definitely stronger together and it takes a lot of time and resources to keep the city running. Here are updates on three main points from my campaign.

Public safety- This past week we swore in a seasoned officer to our police department. In collaboration with the council we agreed to add two officers this year instead of one to help achieve optimal staffing. With more officers it is easier to be proactive instead of reactive.

City Image- We also approved in the new budget to hire a part time dedicated code specialist. This position will allow for continuity and equality when dealing with enforcement. It will alleviate a lot of the extra work put on the police and fire departments, who currently handle these violations. Most importantly it will help to keep our city beautiful and clean.

Updated Vision and Plan- We worked on our annexation plan, landscaping ordinances to permit more water wise options and will start on nuisance ordinances next. I look forward to implementing a five year budget so we can continue to save annually for big expenditures across all departments.

Please get involved, there are many opportunities to serve and give back to Clinton City. Please take a minute to stop by and say hi at our Elected Officials booth at Clinton City Heritage Days.

A MESSAGE FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Clinton City Fire Department is excited to announce that as of July 1st, Clinton City Fire Department will begin running our own paramedic service. For the last 40+ years, the Davis County Sheriff's office has been providing paramedics for cities throughout the county. Due to the vast expansion of the county, as well as an increased need locally, Clinton City is now providing Advanced Life Support (ALS) services to our citizens. We would like to sincerely thank the Davis County Sheriff's office for providing this service to Clinton City for so many years.

Over the last 6 months, we have hired 6 full time Paramedics who have hundreds of hours of clinical and field training. They are trained in advanced cardiac life support, pediatric advanced life support, and advanced airway management. Paramedic service offers a higher level of patient care and we are excited for the opportunity to bring this service to the citizens of Clinton City.
