Clinton City's Recreation Department is full of rock stars! They are always hard at work. They start planning months, if not years, in advance. You may only see one employee at the front desk or at an event but there are many more working behind the scenes. Please let them know how much you appreciate their dedication and all the activities.

Brooke Mitchell has been the department head since 2021. She has worked for Clinton for 23 years. The team is made up of 4 full-time employees, 3 part-time and 70 officials, site supervisors and clinicians. That doesn't count the many volunteer coaches.

The recreation department aims to have four main events a year. About once a quarter there is something fun to participate in. The year starts with the Easter Egg Bash, or otherwise known as "Gone in 60 seconds!" The Easter Bunny always attends and likes taking pictures with citizens. Heritage Days requires all employees to work a little extra. All hands are on deck and the celebration requires tons of planning along with many hours from employees and volunteers. In the fall, the city puts on the Halloween Walk. The weather always seems to hit us with rain or snow but Rec is quick to make it work. I am always amazed at how creative children are. I enjoy watching my boys' carve their pumpkins and decorate luminaries. They are always proud to have their handiwork on display. Recently they started the Blitzen Bash tradition. This is a great chance to take some pictures with Santa. I have never seen horns as large as the ones on last year's reindeer. Yes, reindeer stop in Clinton!

Besides these large events the recreation department handles all of the youth and adult leagues and sports in town. Recently metal signs have been installed around town showing what signups are open. They also put on summer classes for kids.

Recreation makes sure Club 55 lunch and Bingo happens every third Wednesday of the month at noon. If you are over 55 please come join us. The department also hosts Lunch with the Mayor once a month during school. Each elementary school sends one chosen student per grade to take a tour of city hall and spend time with our police and fire.

The main festivities are on Friday, June 9th and Saturday, June 10th. The city council and I will have a booth, please stop by and say hello. Looking forward to meeting you all!

Candidates are subject to financial disclosure requirements identified in (UCA 10-3-208).
