### MAYOR'S MINUTE

Are you ready to rock? Let's get this party started! School is out and the weather is finally heating up. It's time to kick off the summer with our Heritage Days celebration this week. We want you to have a blast.

Anyone looking for the carnival? I just saw it at the Layton Hills Mall, but, unfortunately, it ended this past Sunday. If you drive by Civic Center Park, you won't see it being set up. Good news! You can catch it at the Utah State Fair in 90 days.

Last year there were two big changes to Heritage Days that were both well received. The first change was the date. In the past, it was held the third week in July. Historically, the end of July is the hottest time of year on average in Utah. The new date is the second Saturday in June. This has helped with attendance and the comfort of attendees.

The second change was not having a carnival. This was a very difficult choice because it has been a mainstay for years. The renewal contract would have required the city to host the carnival for a minimum of three days, and it would operate until 11pm. Incidents requiring police at Heritage Days had been increasing year after year. The majority of individuals who were causing disturbances-fighting, lighting fireworks into the crowd, and involved in the shooting- were not Clinton residents. With the changes made to Heritage Days, last year had the least number of calls for police service in a long while.

I heard from a prior council member that last year was the first time his family had attended in a long while. He said how much better they liked the new format and that it reminded him of the past, a celebration full of family fun.

There are so many activities, please check the city's website for times and locations. There will be a petting zoo, pony rides, and inflatables free for the kids. Bring the whole family to the foam party. You can find me at the cornhole tournament. I learned last year some contestants can throw a "4 bagger." That's my new goal. You will also see me jamming on the city council float since Clinton Rocks!

Please take some time to visit the Elected Officials' booth. The city council and I will be taking turns. We'll have games and prizes for the kids and discount cards from local businesses, while supplies last. We enjoy meeting and talking with each of you.

Through the summer, UDOT will finalize agreements with utility companies and nearby landowners – including Hill Air Force Base, Davis and Weber Counties Canal Company, businesses, and residents – to prepare for the advertisement to contractors this fall. Construction is scheduled to begin early 2025.
