2017 MUNICIPAL ELECTION INFORMATION

Offices to be voted on in the 2017 Clinton City Municipal Election are: Mayor - 4 year term and Two (2) City Council Members – each 4 year terms.

Declaration of Candidacy Forms or Nomination Petition must be filed in person with the City Recorder at 2267 N 1500 W Clinton, Utah between the hours of 8am and 5pm. The Candidate Filing Period is from Thursday June 1, 2017 to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday June 7, 2017. (UCA 10-3-301)

Candidates are subject to financial disclosure requirements identified in (UCA 10-3-208).

The Primary Election if needed will be held August 15, 2017. The General Election will be held on November 7, 2017.

A MESSAGE FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

With summer around the corner we want to remind everyone about Title 18 of the Clinton City Ordinances which defines a Nuisance as: any unsightly or injurious object, structure, or disused or abandoned motor vehicles or equipment, or injurious or noxious weeds, trash, junk, refuse or garbage, grass or weeds over ten (10) inches high, or anything dangerous to human life or health, or anything rendering the soil, air, water or food to be impure or unwholesome. We appreciate your help in making this a beautiful and safe community to live in. Please follow these steps to report nuisance concerns: Go to www.clintoncity.net; Click on Report a Concern; Click on the category that best fits your concern; Login to Request Tracker or if it is your first time click on the new user button; Fill out the concern form and click the submit button. As your concern is remedied you will receive email updates as to where your concern is as it follows the process.

WATER SYSTEM RATE INCREASE REMINDER

As a reminder, last month's Newsletter included information pertaining to a \$4.50/month water rate increase effective with the May billing cycle which arrives in homes in June with this issue of the newsletter. The increase will set up the program for replacing the old Ductile Iron water pipe system throughout the City and allow the use of existing fund balances to install the new water main line on 2300 North (part of the identified 1800 North project) to provide a redundant water supply source. NOTICE OF SEWER INCREASES

The City sewer costs are divided into 2 separate areas: the City cost of maintaining the City's system and payment to the North Davis Sewer District (NDS) for treatment of the sewage according to state and federal standards. To accommodate the need for improvements in the NDS transport and treatment facilities, in 2014, they began a four year process of increasing their fees by \$3 per customer per month each year through 2017. As a result, this year marks the last \$3 per month increase. These fee increases are strictly pass through fees to the NDS. This increase will be reflected in the August bill. Thank you.

SAFE EXCHANGE ZONE AVAILABLE IN CLINTON

Clinton City residents don't have to worry about a safe place to make that Craigslist or KSL Sale switch. The Police Department has created a safe exchange zone by designating 3 parking stalls directly north of the Police building at 2209 N 1500 W as a safe exchange zone. The safe zone is under 24 hour surveillance, in a well-lit, visible location and is clearly identified with signs.

We hope this can be used as a safe place for residents to meet and complete a transaction, or to do parental custody exchanges.
