CLINTON CITY EMERGENCY CONTACT & NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

WE WILL BE CONDUCTING A TEST OF OUR EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM ON WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 13 BY SENDING OUT A MESSAGE. If you haven't already done so, now is a good time to sign up for the Clinton City Emergency Contact and Notification System. Or, if you have already signed up, it's a good idea to review your account information and make updates if necessary.

To sign up, click on the **Red Phone** (below) to follow the link to our website at www.clintoncity.com or, go to the website and click on the **Red Phone**. By registering, you can specify how you will receive notifications and you can keep your profile updated with accurate contact information to insure you are notified of important information or an emergency.

Please note that our Emergency Contact System is automatically and regularly updated through our Utility Billing system. If your information on file is not accurate, and you have not registered on our website, you may not receive EMERGENCY NOTICES. Please call our Utilities Department at 801-614-0700 to update your billing information.

If you are an owner of a rental property, please encourage your renters to register for notifications on our website, as this is the only way they will receive notifications or alerts.

When registering, please make sure to respond to the verification email to complete the registration process; check your e-mail including the junk mail folder for your verification email from Cloudspeaker (the provider) and respond to it to complete your registration. Also, check your security settings to allow messages to be delivered to your in box in the future. Thank you!

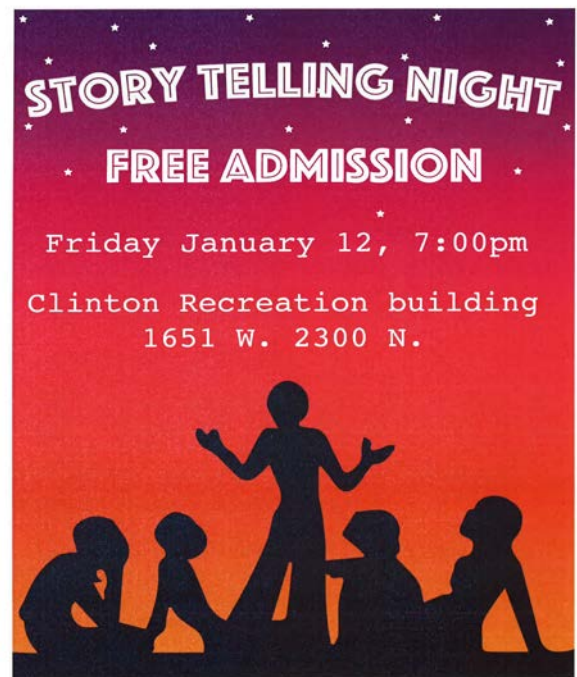
NOTICE OF 2018 BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL
