Department: Full Time Streets Maintenance Worker

RESPONSIBILITIES:

A *Public Works Maintenance Worker* is responsible for performing a variety of unskilled or skilled maintenance work in the construction, operation, repair and maintenance of City facilities. Workers in this position class are normally assigned to work in a specific division of the department but will be assigned or reassigned to work in any area of the department as needed. The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance of parks and trails, city streets, sewer/storm drain, water system, buildings and facilities and in other related areas.

The position may require the operation of city-owned vehicles, such as pick-up trucks, backhoes, mowers, street sweeper, dump trucks, salt spreaders, snow plows, etc. as required. The operation of power tools and equipment, such as chain saws, air compressor, etc. when required is also necessary. The candidate will be required to inspect and repair equipment.

VOLUNTEER FOR OUR COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT)"

Cert is continuing its new on-line course. An introduction to the on-line course will be held on Tuesday, January 22nd at 6:30 pm in the training room at the Clinton City Fire Station.

This is our 2nd session of the on-line course which gives you the freedom to learn at home. Nine (9) hours of home study are required. When completed, you will then be required to have 16 hours of hands on study; learning skills to work in a disaster setting: disaster medical #1 and #2; fire suppression; transporting victims; leveraging, lifting heavy objects; assembling a medical and preparedness kit; search and rescue techniques; and how to keep yourself safe.
