Class "C" fireworks can be sold the following dates:
June 24 – July 25
December 29 - December 31
2 days before and on Chinese New Year's Eve

Discharge

Between the hours of 11 am and 11 pm except as noted:
July 2 - July 5
(July 4 hours extended to midnight)
December 31
(11 am – 1 am Jan 1)
Chinese New Year's Eve
(11am – 1 am the following day)

The Clinton City Fire Department would like to remind the citizens of Clinton to responsibly discharge their fireworks and novelties while enjoying this holiday season.

We encourage everyone as they celebrate the independence of our country and the arrival of the pioneers to our mountain valleys to do it with safety being their primary focus. According to the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission 280 People on average go to the emergency room with fireworks-related injuries daily around the 4th of July holiday.

Also, keep in mind that this year, due to extremely dry conditions, there is a higher risk for fires. Please keep a bucket of water on hand or hose running nearby during lighting and disposing of fireworks. Thank you!

Hotline & Services for High-risk Individuals

Contact and Flag Football Registration

CONTACT FOOTBALL DEADLINE JULY 2nd!! NO late registrations. Only COMPLETE packets are accepted. Contact Football: Ages 7-15, must weigh at least 40 lbs and not be registered for high school. Cost is \$110. Packets can be picked up in our office or found online and must be completed to register.

Flag Football: Co-ed ages 1st-9th grade. Cost is \$50 resident and \$55 non-resident. Registration includes a game jersey and 8 games, the **deadline is July 31st.**

Fall Soccer Registration

Registration runs through July 17th. Cost is \$50.00 for residents and \$55.00 for non-residents. The season runs August - October. Youth ages 4 (preschool – must start kindergarten fall of 2021) to **9th grade.** Registration information is at www.clintoncity.net or www.activityreg.com

Fall Adult Slow Pitch Softball

Signups for the fall slow pitch leagues run June 1st – July 31st. Co-ed leagues available Monday and Tuesday nights and Men’s league available on Monday nights. Cost is \$400 per team with an 8 game guarantee including a single elimination tournament at conclusion of the regular league play.

Fall Adult Kickball League

Adult co-ed kickball league for ages 16 and older. Cost will be \$350 per team. The league will run on Wednesday nights at our civic center complex. Men’s Adult 5v5v5 softball

This is a fun new Men’s league we are offering this fall. Cost is \$300 per team.

How it works:

- A game consists of three teams of 5-6 players rotating through the infield, outfield and batting positions per inning (9 outs per inning)
- Each game runs 5 innings with no new inning starting after 60 minutes.
- The team with the most runs gets 3 points, the team with second most runs gets 2 points and team with the least amount of runs get 1 point.

NOTICE OF PASS THROUGH UTILITY RATE INCREASES

Beginning with the July utility bill that will arrive in homes in August, the City will be implementing the following fee increases:

- \$.15 per month per household for Animal Control fees (\$1.25)
- \$.10 per month per household for Dispatch Services (\$1.05)

Please note these increases are strictly pass through fees the City is being charged by these service providers.
