

OFFICIAL NOTICE OF THE CLINTON CITY MUNICIPAL ELECTION

April 22, 2025

Clinton City will hold an election on August 12th (Primary as needed) and November 4, 2025 to elect the following offices:

- Mayor (4-year term)
- Two (2) City Council positions (4-year term)

The candidate filing period is between June 2, 2025, and June 6, 2025, Monday through Friday, except weekends and holidays. A Declaration of Candidacy must be filed in person from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the City Recorder's office, 2267 N 1500 W, (lower level) Clinton. A \$25.00 filing fee is required to file.

Candidates must meet the following qualifications:

- Registered Voter in the municipality in which the individual is elected
- Must have resided within the municipality for which the candidate is seeking office for the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
- Maintain a principal place of residence within the municipality, and within the district that the elected office represents, during the officer's term of office.
- If the individual resides in a territory which was annexed into the municipality: must have resided within the annexed territory or the municipality the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
- Pay filing fee, if one is required by municipal ordinance.
- Not convicted of a felony
- Cannot have been declared mentally incompetent.

If you are a military (currently deployed) or an overseas citizen eligible to vote in state and local elections, you may register to vote and request a regular absentee ballot for upcoming elections.
